



PARKS & RECREATION

The following is a partial list of the rules of conduct that apply to all users and persons who are within the parks and recreation areas of the Town, including Woodland Lake Park, which is federal land owned by the U.S. Department of Agriculture, U.S. Forest Service.

Park hours are from official daylight to 10:00 p.m., April 1 – October 31. From November 1 – March 31, park hours are from official daylight to official sunset.

Park use is available on a first-come, first-serve basis except as scheduled for:

- C. **Reserving Ramadas:** There are four (4) small Ramadas and one (1) large Ramada. Only two (2) of the five (5) may be reserved on any given day. Reservations must be made through the Parks & Recreation Dept. The fee for the small Ramadas is \$20; the fee for the large Ramada is \$30. All Ramada reservations must include a separate \$25 refundable cleaning deposit.

The maximum speed limit is fifteen (15) m.p.h.

No person shall leave a vehicle standing or parked in established parking areas or elsewhere in the parks and recreation areas during hours when the area is closed.

All-terrain Vehicles (ATVs) and other motorized off-road vehicles are not allowed in the parks and shall not be used in parks unless such vehicle is licensed for street/road use by the Arizona Department of Motor Vehicles. All vehicles must stay on paved roads and only be parked in designated parking areas.

All boats must conform to the Arizona Game and Fish Department laws and regulations governing registration and operation.

Only beer and wine are allowed in areas of Town parks which are not in use for league and team use as defined in section 12.12.040.A.1.a. No alcoholic beverage may be sold in Town parks.

Glass beverage bottles and containers are not allowed in the parks.

Swimming is strictly prohibited in Woodland Lake.

Park users shall abide by all Forest Service Fire Restrictions.

No person shall engage in threatening, abusive, insulting or indecent language or engage in disorderly conduct or behavior tending to breach the public peace.

Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times in the Parks. Pets are subject to the Town's Animal Control Ordinance.

The Town Police Department, the Code Enforcement Office, and employees of the Parks & Recreation Department have the authority to enforce the provisions of Chapter 12.12 of the Town Code.
